NCIC recognizes that many of our customers need guidance on how to bring healing to themselves and their family members. Recharge, now offered in over 150 correctional facilities, has proven to be the vehicle through which an incarcerated or formerly incarcerated person can express what their reality is, what they wrestle with and face each day, to reflect on and process their incarceration and life experiences together, and to feel valued and connected. It provides the structure for people to communicate their feelings in a positive way, while also opening discussion and building bridges, understanding, trust and genuine connection.

Recharge has had significant impact on those who have utilized it, and has been enthusiastically embraced by even the most resistant users. Formerly incarcerated people who had been non-communicative for years find themselves opening up, becoming expressive, having a range of feelings again, and have been reported to be more communicative since participating in this game.
